

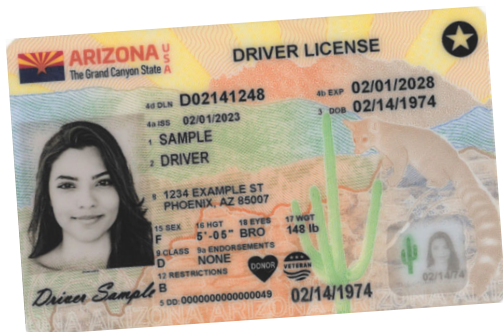
ID assistance and Community Resource
